



## CCEA New Sprouts Chinese Summer Camp 2010 Application

### **About CCEA**

The Chinese Cultural Education Association (CCEA) New Sprouts Chinese School will be offering its fourth annual Chinese Summer Camp July-August. We are a 501(c)(3) non-profit, non-religious organization committed to educating and sharing Chinese language and culture with the children of the East Bay communities.

### **Program Description**

CCEA New Sprouts Chinese Summer Camp is an enrichment program that provides opportunities to explore and understand Chinese culture and language through daily routines and cultural activities taught by experienced bilingual teachers who are native Chinese speakers. No prior knowledge of Chinese is necessary for this camp though communication will be conducted primarily in Chinese. This camp is designed for children entering K-6 in Fall 2010 (ages 4.5 through 12 years old and must be toilet trained and non-nappers).

Your child will have fun learning the Chinese language and culture by participating in our immersion-based activities including, but not limited to a variety of: arts & crafts, dance & movement, stories, sports & games, brush painting, cooking and a special Chinese cultural theme incorporated throughout the weekly schedule. Each week's cultural focus is unique and includes a local field trip and take home projects. Your child will come home from this summer camp enriched in Chinese culture, language and friendship.

### **Program Dates and Weekly Themes:**

New Sprouts Summer Camp runs for 4 weeks from the last week of July through August. You may enroll for one week, 2 weeks, 3 weeks or all 4 weeks at a time. Enrollment is first-come, first-serve.

Please use the web link to get directions to the campsite. The classroom entrance is on the right side of 1255 First Avenue entrance (between 12<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Street); it is a one-way street and easy to miss. If you are new to this area, allow yourself extra time.

Parking: There is a parking lot available with limited spaces for drop off and pick up at the 1255 First Avenue entrance. Additional street parking is available on 1330 Lakeshore Avenue entrance.

### **Tuition & Fees**

Camp Fee:

One week	\$280 (Offered at the same price as 2008 & 2009)
Two weeks:	\$560
Three weeks:	\$798 (5% savings - \$266 per week)
Four weeks:	\$1008 (10% savings - \$252 per week)

Siblings receive 10% tuition discount

Extended Care: \$75 per week or \$20 per day drop-in

Refund and Transfer—

We have a **no refund policy** for summer camps. We understand that your plans may change over the course of the summer so weeks are transferable, if space is available. Exceptions due to family illness or unforeseeable circumstances must be reviewed and approved by the Head of School.

### **Registration**

Once a complete application is received, your spot is secured and will be confirmed by email. CCEA operates primarily through email communication so a reliable email address is required.

- New Sprouts will hold an orientation session on **Saturday, July 24 at 10:30 am** prior to summer camp beginning to welcome all our new summer families and so you can meet the staff to learn more about the program.
- Parent participation is strongly encouraged (**suggested one hour a week per family**) to assist with field trips, special activities, class room help, etc. A sign-up will be provided at orientation.
