New Sprouts

New Sprouts Chinese School was created three years ago by a group of parents seeking quality Chinese education for their children in Oakland. Over the years, the school has grown to accommodate children from all over the Bay Area ranging in age from preschool to grade school. Our goal is to excite and engage children in Chinese language and cultures by immersing them in a fun and interactive environment full of new learning and discoveries.

Program Description

We offer classes in Mandarin Chinese, with an emphasis on language and culture. Class instruction is conducted in Mandarin by native-speaking teachers. The focus of the beginner class is to develop the student’s listening and speaking skills. Each lesson incorporates greetings, music, new vocabulary, stories, and games. Our lessons are appropriate for all levels and our curriculum is progressive. Our unique curriculum incorporates a well-established online learning tool for at home reinforcement. New students who would like to enroll in intermediate or advanced level are required to schedule a mandatory assessment upon enrollment. Except the Parent-and-Todd class, all classes are drop-off only. Parents may stay in the first two classes to help your child acclimate to the new environment.

Starting in Spring 2010, we are offering a new **Parent-and-Tot class** on Friday morning for children, 18 months to 3 years old to attend the 50-minute class with a parent or caregiver. Children from age 2.9 to 5 years old can attend the 60-minute drop-off Pre-K classes on Friday or Saturday morning. These classes include lots of circle time, story, music & movement, crafts and a snack break.

K-2nd and 3rd-6th Grade classes are offered on Saturday and Sunday. Class instruction is 75 minutes long. Children are introduced to the verbal and written language of Chinese through interactive and fun activities, music, and games.
