About CCEA

Back by popular demand, The Chinese Cultural Education Association (CCEA) New Sprouts Chinese School will be offering its second annual Chinese Immersion Summer Camp this August. We are a 501(c)(3) non-profit, non-religious learning organization committed to educating and sharing Chinese language and culture to the children of the East Bay communities.

Program Description

This is a 3 week **immersion Mandarin** language program, infused with fun cultural activities for your child, and taught by experienced bilingual Chinese teachers. No prior knowledge of Chinese is necessary for this camp though communication will be conducted primarily in Chinese.

Your child will have fun learning the language and culture of China by participating in our immersion-based activities including, but not limited a variety of: arts & crafts, Chinese dance & movement, stories, fables, sports & games, brush painting, cooking and a special Chinese cultural theme incorporated throughout the weekly schedule. Each week's cultural focus is unique and includes a local field trip and take home projects. Your child will come home from this summer camp enriched in Chinese culture, language and friendship.

Program Details

New Sprouts Summer Camp runs for 3 weeks in August. You may enroll for one week, two weeks or 3 weeks at a time. Enrollment is first-come, first-serve.

- Week 1: 8/4-8/8, Week 2: 8/11-8/15, Week 3: 8/18-8/22.
- Program is from 9:00am – 3:00pm. Drop-off time is 8:45-9:00am.
- Extended care is available from 8:30-9:00am and 3:00-6:00pm.
- This camp is appropriate for children ages 4 (must be toilet trained and non-nappers) through 12 years old.
- Camp space allows for tailored instruction per age grouping. Camp begins and ends in large group format with break-out sessions all throughout the day for specific activities. Camp group targets: PreK-K; 1st-3rd graders; 4th-6th graders.
- Low teacher to camper ratio.
- Older children (6-12) will participate in one culturally-related field trip per week.
- Qualified bilingual teachers on-site full time, CPR and First Aid certified.

Wang Lao Shi is Director of CCEA Curriculum Development, and also teaches New Sprouts Sunday classes. She will be the head teacher of our camp, along with two other equally qualified head teachers and assistant teachers. She has boundless amounts of energy, passion and dedication to her students.

Basic Procedures

- Camp begins at 9:00am. Drop-off period is from 8:45 to 9am. Extended care may arrive at 8:30am and ends at 6pm. Please be considerate and prompt with your pick up. \$1/minute will be charged for late pick ups after 6pm.
- There is a parking lot available with limited spaces for drop off and pick up at the 1255 First Avenue entrance. Additional street parking is available on 1330 Lakeshore Avenue entrance.
- Snacks are provided twice a day. We prepare healthy, nutritious snacks and fresh fruits during snack times. Water, not juice or milk, will be provided.
- We ask parents to pack a lunch for their child everyday except on Fridays. We have access to a microwave and a refrigerator.
- On Fridays, the camp will have Chinese Cooking day, included with tuition. **If your child has any food allergies, make sure you explain this in detail on your registration form.**
- There is an outdoor play structure as well as games conducted by teachers daily. Please dress your child appropriately, pack sunscreen, and bring an extra set of clothing in necessary. No flip-flops on the play structure will be allowed.
- New Sprouts will hold an orientation session prior to summer camp beginning to welcome all our new summer families and so you can meet the teachers. Date TBD.
- We require **one hour a week** of parent participation to assist with field trips and special activities, snack purchases, etc. A sign-up will be provided at orientation.
- Parents will also be given a list of basic necessities to purchase and bring with your child for the duration of your time at summer camp. All other classroom and activity materials are included with your tuition.
- A class roster and contact list will be sent to all registered families. Please notify us when your child is not able to attend class so we do not worry!
